


INTERIOR DESIGN CONCEPTS



The Transitional Hawaiian design uses warmer wood tones but applies them in a more contemporary fashion, accented by textured ceramic tiles and natural patterned stones. The Modern Island design breaks away from the traditional materials, but retains a distinct island feel, by using a cooler palette of wood tones in combination with natural stones and modern glass tiles.
